

Information about our processing of your personal data

Who is the administrator of your data?

The administrator of your data is the Kosciuszko Institute Association with its registered office at ul. Wilhelma Feldman 4/9-10, 31-130 Kraków, Poland, entered into the register of associations, other social and professional organisations, foundations and independent public healthcare institutions of the National Court Register by the District Court for Kraków-Śródmieście in Kraków, XI Commercial Division, under NCR (KRS) number 0000145838, TIN (NIP) 6751302992, REGON 356683760; e-mail: instytut@ik.org.pl.

Why will we process your data?

We will need your data in order to send you a Newsletter about our activity, including invitations to the upcoming editions of the CYBERSEC Forum.

How long will we store your data?

We will store your data for as long as we will publish and distribute our Newsletter, unless, of course, you object to being sent the Newsletter.

Who can we transfer your data to?

In accordance with the law in force, we may transfer your data to entities that process it at our request, e.g. to electronic service providers, our PR company, etc. Your personal data may be transferred by designated entities to third countries in accordance with the RODO.

What are your rights with respect to your data?

You have the right to request access to, change, delete or limit the processing of your data, as well as to object to the processing and transfer of your data. You can also file an objection to the processing of your personal data at any time.

It is, of course, not mandatory for us to possess your personal data (i.e. it is not a legal or contractual requirement). If you file a complaint, we will delete your personal data immediately. If you do, however, we will not be able to send you our Newsletter.

You also have the right to file a complaint with the Chairman of the Office of Personal Data Protection (ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa) if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

What is the legal basis for the processing of your data?

We process your personal data because we want to maintain contact with you via our Newsletter. The Newsletter is a form of direct marketing, which in turn – in light of the law in force – constitutes the legitimate interest of the data administrator (Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter f of the GDPR). Therefore, the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is our legitimate interest as the administrator of your data.

Objection to the processing of personal data

Again, we would like to underline that you have the right to object, at any time and free of charge, to our processing of your personal data. If you wish to file such an objection, contact us via e-mail at the following address: instytut@ik.org.pl.
